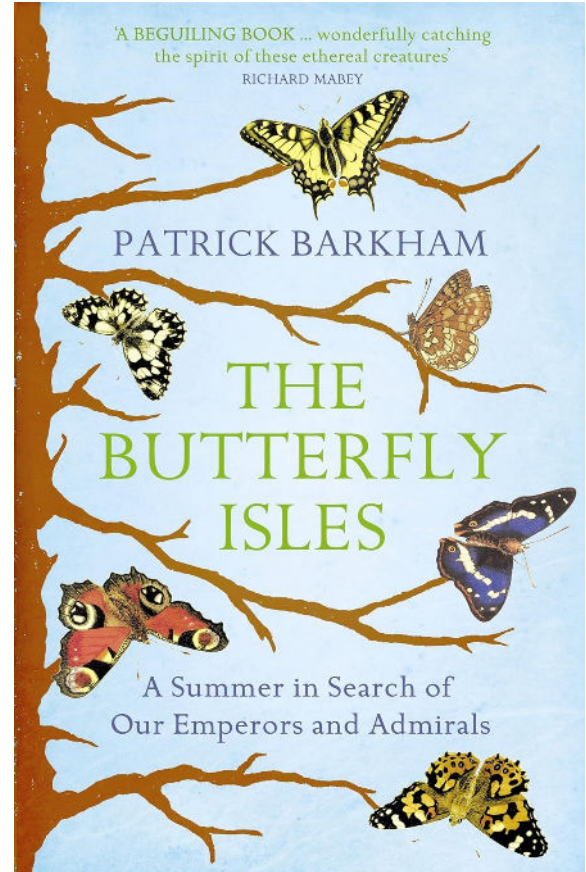

# Butterfly Photograph Challenge

## How it Works? (1)

- You must take the photograph yourself
- The photograph needs to be clear enough to identify which species it is
- Your parent (including for Seniors) needs to email your photograph (only one per species) to Mr Fletcher on: [headmaster@heritageschool.org.uk](mailto:headmaster@heritageschool.org.uk)

## **Butterfly Photograph Challenge: How it Works? (2)**

- The email from your parent must confirm:
  - Your name
  - That YOU took the photograph by yourself
  - What species of butterfly it is
  - Precisely where and when you took the photograph

## **Butterfly Photograph Challenge: How it Works? (3)**

- We will print off one of clearest photographs and put it on a display board. (So we can all see how many species we have photographed TOGETHER.)
- We'll keep a record for everyone who participates, and which species of butterfly you have successfully photographed. (So try and photograph as many as YOU can!)

## Butterfly Photograph Challenge: How it Works? (4)

- There will be a competition: **Infants/Juniors vs Seniors!**
- We'll announce which individual pupils – from Infants, Juniors and Seniors – have successfully photographed **the largest number of UK species** at Sports Day.
- We'll announce which individual pupils – from Infants, Juniors and Seniors – we think took **the best butterfly picture**.
